III. DESCRIPTION

1. Background

Replacement of the Colton Avenue bridge is part of the overall Mouse River Plan. Replacement of the bridge will improve conveyance at the crossing. The project was initially programmed to be a part of the Burlington levee project; however when bid prices for Phases 1, 2, and 3 in Minot came in below budget, some of the funds were reprogrammed to advance other phases of the Mouse River Plan.

B. Proposed Project

The Souris River Joint Board intends to bid phase BU-1A, Colton Avenue Bridge Replacement. The existing bridge will be replaced with a longer span bridge. Other project elements include scour protection and tie-ins to the existing and future proposed levees.

Consultant selection was done by SRJB in accordance with ND State Water Commission requirements
