A. Background

The Fire Department is switching to iPads which are much less expensive and user friendly for our needs. To make this equipment work with our Emergency Reporting software, we budgeted money for a one time set up fee and year one of recurring fees with Tyler Technologies for their New World Crew Force Software. This switch will save money over time due to the reduced cost of replacing equipment.

An amendment to the current Tyler Technologies software agreement is necessary to allow the switch to the new, less expensive equipment.
