III. DESCRIPTION

A. Background

The Minot Police Department has participated in this annual traffic safety grant program on an ongoing basis. The funds are used to pay officers to work in an overtime capacity and increase enforcement of impaired driving, occupant protection, distracted driving, underage drinking, and speed enforcement in an effort to make Minot a safer community.

B. Proposed Project

The Minot Police Department would like authorization to apply for and accept a grant in the amount of \$52,875 from the ND Department of Transportation Traffic Safety Division for the overtime enforcement of Occupant Protection (\$9,400), Impaired Driving (\$22,325), Underage Drinking (\$7,050), and Distracted Driving (\$7,050) and Speed Enforcement (\$7,050) The grant period is October 1st, 2020 to December, 2021.
