The Souris River Joint Board and the City of Minot held a Public Input Meeting for the Mouse River Enhanced Flood Protection Project Phase MI-5 Northeast Tieback Levee. The meeting took place at the Roosevelt Elementary School and began with an Open House at 6:30 p.m. and Formal Presentation at 7:00 p.m.

David Ashley, with the Souris River John Board, began with an introduction at 7:08 p.m. explaining the importance of everyone's attendance.
